Option	Age	Living Arrangement	Rental Assistance	Additional Funds	Requirements
<b>THP+FC</b>	Age 18-21	Apartment, studio, rented room in house	Deposit and up to \$1300/month depending, fully paid directly to landlord	<p>\$200/every 2 weeks</p> <p>\$200/month mandatory savings</p> <p>Incentives for housing inspection/weekly meeting with ILP coordinator</p>	<p>20 hours/week of a job, school, or life prep activity</p> <p>Meet with ILP coordinator 1x week, SW 1x/month, court every 6 months</p>
<b>SILP</b>	Age 18-21	Alone, with a roommate, dorm, or with a supportive adult	<p>\$883/month given directly to you</p> <p>For rent and any additional financial needs</p>	The \$883 you get each month has to cover all of your expenses	<p>Job, school, or life prep activity</p> <p>Meet with SW 1x/month, court every 6 months</p>
<b>Foster Home</b>	Age 18-21	Foster parent becomes "landlord"	Rent fully paid directly to foster parent/landlord	SW talks to landlord about what to give youth	<p>Job, school, or life prep activity</p> <p>Meet with SW 1x/month, court every 6 months</p>



## Housing Options for Age 18-25

<b>Relative or Family Friend</b>	Age 18-21	With relative or family friend, a rented room	Can be through SILP or THP+FC	SW talks with relative or family friend about the importance of helping youth manage \$ and how much would be appropriate to give them	Job, school, or life prep activity  Meet with SW 1x/month, court every 6 months
<b>THP+</b>	Age 21-25	Alone or with roommate	Deposit and rent fully paid for the first 4 months  Every 4 months after that youth pays 10% of rent	Gift cards for meeting weekly, passing a housing inspection, budgeting, and completing goals. Reimbursement for utilities	Job, school, or life prep activity  Must have enough income to pay your rent as it goes up
