Responsibility of Mandated Reporters

- To Report <u>"Reasonable Suspicion</u>" of Child Abuse or Neglect, as soon as possible, by phone to Children's Protective services or law enforcement agencies.
- To identify themselves when making the report.
- To provide information about the identity of the child and family where abuse/neglect is suspected, including contact information if possible.
- To provide as much information as is available about the identity of the suspected abuser and his/her access to children.
- To follow-up the phone report with a written report within 36 hours.
- To cooperate with investigation of suspected child abuse or neglect

If there are several mandated reporters involved, <u>each</u> one is separately and individually responsible for being sure report is made although only one actually has to make the report. COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ

Responsibility of Child Protective Services

- Accept Reports of Suspected Child/Abuse Neglect from the Community
- Investigate Reports Promptly (generally, within 24 hours or within 10 days of referral depending on the information given.)
- Assess Damage to Children
- Evaluate the Risk of Further Injury and Consider the Need for Outof-Home Placement to Protect the Children
- Identify the Family's Strengths and Problems as They Relate to the Safety of the Children
- Evaluate the Potential for Treatment (Consider Voluntary or Court-Ordered Services)
- Plan a Course of Treatment (Service Plan).
- Initiate & Monitor the Service Plan
- Invoke the Authority of the Juvenile Court and Work with Families under the Court's Orders.
- If children are placed in foster care, the goal of services is to either safely return children to parents' care within 6 or 12 months, or to find an alternative safe and permanent home for children.
